The following is a brief summary of the Board of Education meeting held on June 8, 2017.

PERSONNEL

The Board accepted the retirement request of Glenda Stephenson as Para-Professional at Sparta Lincoln School.

The extra-curricular recommendations were approved as presented for Sparta Lincoln School.

John Vercellino was approved as an Assistant Coach for Boys' Basketball at Sparta High School.

Jarrod Ostlund was employed as a Social Studies/Drivers' Education Teacher at Sparta High School.

Mark Riley was employed as a 10-month Assistant Principal at Sparta High School with a one-year contract for the 2017-2018 school year with an annual salary of \$50,000.

Jayson Baker was employed as an 11-month Principal at Evansville Attendance Center with a one-year contract for the 2017-2018 school year with an annual salary of \$52,000.

A three-year contract was approved for Dr. Gabrielle Schwemmer as Superintendent with an annual salary of \$112,100 for the 2017-2018 school year; \$117,100 for the 2018-2019 school year and \$122,100 for the 2019-2020 school year.

FINANCE

The bid from Waste Management was approved in the amount of \$720 per month for daily trash removal services for the district for the 2017-2018 school year.

The bid from Midland Paper was approved in the amount of \$21.62 per case for copier paper for the district for the 2017-2018 school year.

The Board adopted the Resolution Abating the Working Cash fund of Sparta CUSD #140. The amount of \$860,000 will be permanently transferred to the education fund.

The administrator and non-union non-certified staff pay increases for the 2017-2018 school year were approved as presented.

MISCELLANEOUS

Howard Gallois was appointed as the Board Representative for Perandoe Special Education District and for the IASB Governing Board for the 2017-2018 school year.

A plaque was presented to Mekalia Cooper for her service to the Board of Education. Mark North and Terry Waldron were not in attendance.

An additional kindergarten class was discussed for Sparta Lincoln School. Currently there will be 23 students per classroom.

Mrs. Price asked the Board of Education to consider allowing fifth grade students at Sparta Lincoln School to play sports.

The summer cleaning was discussed. With several 10-month custodians now employed, the work will not all be completed before school starts.

The next regular board meeting is scheduled for 7 p.m. on Thursday, July 13, 2017, at Sparta Lincoln School.
