*The following is a brief summary of the Board of Education meeting held on July 13, 2017.*

### PERSONNEL

The Board accepted the resignation of Jenny Silbe as 2<sup>nd</sup> grade teacher at Sparta Lincoln School.

Angela Carter was employed as a 6-8 grade Math/Science teacher at Sparta Lincoln School.

Chelsey Burley was employed as a 2<sup>nd</sup> grade teacher at Evansville Attendance Center.

Hannah Parker was employed as a PE teacher at Evansville Attendance Center.

Pete Spritler was approved as a Volunteer Assistant Football Coach at Sparta High School.

The Board approved a one-year contract with Jayson Baker as an 11-month Principal at Evansville Attendance Center for the 2017-2018 school year with an annual salary of \$52,000 and a \$3,000 stipend for Athletic Director.

### FINANCE

The Board authorized the treasurer to make, as needed for the fiscal year 2018, interfund loans from the operations and maintenance fund to the educational fund or fire prevention and safety fund; or from the educational fund to the operations and maintenance fund or fire prevention and safety fund; or from the operations and maintenance or education fund to the transportation fund; or from the transportation fund to the operations and maintenance, educational or fire prevention and safety fund, and to make the necessary transfers on her books. Such loans shall be repaid and retransferred to the proper fund within three years.

Prevailing wage rates for Randolph County were adopted.

The Board will go out for bids for the Evansville Attendance Center gymnasium flooring.

The Title I plan was approved for the 2017-2018 school year as presented.

### MISCELLANEOUS

Pole banners with the district logo will be put up by the schools in order to promote the district. Community businesses will be offered the chance to sponsor a banner.

The benchmarking assessment systems were discussed. The district will use NWEA instead of STAR.

The organizational chart for the district was presented.

The school handbooks for the 2017-2018 school year were approved as presented.

The Board will retain the legal counsel of Guin Mundorf LLC Attorneys of Collinsville for the 2017-2018 school year.

Fifth grade students at Sparta Lincoln School will be able to participate in extra-curricular activities for the 2017-2018 school year.

The next regular board meeting is scheduled for 7 p.m. on Thursday, August 10, 2017, at Sparta Lincoln School.
